To enrich and enhance the quality of life for North Texas area residents, especially families and children, through free concerts of classical music and educational performances

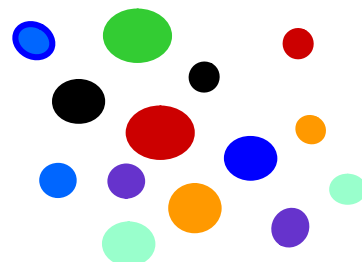

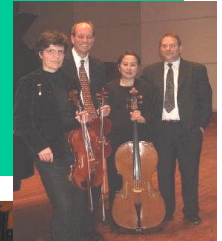
